Each applicant will be assessed on their perceived or proven ability to effectively present their project to a broad audience. Therefore, as part of this application, you **must** submit a sample of your research project work (poster, paper, etc), even if it is in draft form. In addition, a faculty member with close knowledge of your research or creative scholarship (such as your faculty mentor/advisor/professor) will be required to submit an endorsement of your work, your ability to present your results, and positively represent the university using the online form:
